MAA Shooter of the Year

Based on the feedback from last year we are very pleased to announce that this year's series will be structure just as it was last year. Just a couple of changes relative to locations. Bob Rowe's archery club will be participating with a couple of shoots. We'll be posting the locations as they become available. Please keep an eye on the website and Facebook. Howell's Gun & Archery Center has chosen not to participate.

- The series will run from November 7 – March 6
- Target Faces will rotate between Blue/White and Vegas
- Each shooter must post a minimum of 2 Blue/White and 2 Vegas scores. You may post additional scores and the highest two scores on each face will count towards Shooter of the Year.
- Scores may be posted anytime during the series
- Shooters must post scores from at least two different shops.
- Cost will stay the same - \$10/individual, \$8/children and \$20/family max
- Shooters must be members of the MAA so don't forget to renew your membership.

MAA Board of Directors

The positions of President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer are up for re-election. MAA Officer Positions

- President – The President shall be the chief executive officer of MAA and shall preside at all meeting, appoint all committees, and in general perform the duties incumbent of the office of President.
- Vice-President – The Vice-President shall assist the President in the performance of his duties and shall assume the responsibilities of the office of President if the President is unable to act.
- Secretary – The Secretary shall keep the records of the meetings and business of MAA, conduct MAA correspondence as directed by the President, and in general perform the duties incumbent of the office of Secretary.

- Treasurer – The Treasurer shall conduct the financial transactions of MAA as authorized by the Board of Directors, and in general perform the duties incumbent to the office of Treasurer. The Treasurer and the President shall be empowered to write checks in the name of MAA.
