Rules and Regulations

Shooter of the Year runs 11/3/2019 to 3/1/2020 (Follow the link, <https://static1.squarespace.com/static/56a15fe5ab281062188bf726/t/5d9ca5abe58665526d2ced46/1570547119255/MAA+Schedule+2019-2020.pdf> for event Schedule dates and locations).

Weekly Event Cost: Adults: \$15.00 Youth: \$10.00 Family Cap: \$30.00

To be eligible for awards at the end of the Season, an archer must:

- Be a current member of the MAA. Follow the link, <https://www.nfaausa.com/membership/> to register today!
- Must post 2 Blue & White scores and 2 Vegas scores while a current member.
- Must post a score at 2 or more host venues.
- May shoot as many shooting styles as you like, but can only be eligible for up to two Shooter of the Year Awards. One qualifying shooting style can be either compound Freestyle or Bowhunter Freestyle (one release style) and the other shooting style can be either Barebow, Freestyle Limited, Freestyle Limited Recurve, or Traditional (one non-release style).
- Unless otherwise stated the first qualifying style entered will be the first style you shoot in.
- Lines are held at 8:30am and Noon with overflow line at 3:30pm (Call host venues to pre-register. Follow the link for host location contact information <http://www.mainearchery.org/soy-schedules/>).
- Must complete a registration form and waiver form at or before your first shoot. Follow the link <http://www.mainearchery.org/other-information/> to the waiver form.

Awards will be presented at the Maine State Championships on 3/22/2020.
