# MAINE ARCHERY ASSOCIATION

## 14 TARGET, ½ NFAA FIELD FORMAT

This description is specific to Lakeside Archery, Lakeside has an excellent field course that is both fun to shoot and challenging. All target stations are set up so that four shooters can shoot at the same time. This keeps everyone moving so other archers don't need to wait for their turn. Shoot organizers will ensure that new archers are paired up with experienced shooters who are familiar with the course.

Four arrows are shot at each target station.

Through the entire course archers shoot the same order.

Where applicable the bottom targets always shoot first.

When applicable; Archer 1 shoots bottom left, Archer 2 shoots bottom right, Archer 3 shoots top left, Archer 4 shoots top right.

The descriptions below are for the adult stakes. Youth and Cub are marked below description. Cubs shoot a maximum of 30 yards and Youth shoot a maximum of 50 yards

## Target 1 – 15 yards - Walk Back (The Water Fall) (4) 35 cm faces

Two archers shoot the bottom targets, two arrows at each target, and two archers shoot their four arrows at the top two target faces.

Youth: 15 yards Cub: 10 yards

### Target 2 – 35-yard fan – Walk Through (1) 50 cm face

Each archer shoots one arrow from each shooting position. Position 1 =Archer 1, Position 2 =Archer 2, etc. After the archers shoot the first position everyone moves right to the next position and shoots their second arrow. If your first position is position 2 the second arrow is shot at position 3, etc.

Youth: 35 yards, Fan Cub:15 yards, Fan

#### Target 3 – 40 yards – Walk Through (*The Eagles Perch*) (1) 50 cm face

Each archer shoots all four arrows at the single target face.

Youth: 40 yards Cub:18 yards

### Target 4 – 20 yards – Walk Back (4) 35 cm faces

Two archers shoot the bottom targets, two arrows at each target, and two archers shoot their four arrows at the top two target faces.

Youth: 20 yards Cub: 10 yards

## Target 5 – 45 yard - Walkup – Walk Back (The Incline Stepper) (1) 50 cm face

Each archer shoots one arrow from each distance in the order of 45,40,35 then 30.

Youth: 45, 40, 35, 30 yards

**Cub: 20** 

## Target 6 – 45 yards – Walk Through (*The Bridge*) (1) 50 cm face

Each archer shoots all four arrows at the single target face.

Youth: 45 yards Cub: 20 yards

#### <u>Target 7 – 30 yards – Walk Back (4) 35 cm faces</u>

Two archers shoot the bottom targets, two arrows at each target, and two archers shoot their four arrows at the top two target faces.

Youth: 30 yards Cub: 10 yards

## <u>Target 8 – 60 yards – Walk Back (1) 65 cm face</u>

Each archer shoots all four arrows at the single target face.

Youth: 45 yards Cub: 25 yards

## Target 9 – 35 Foot - Walkup – (*The Bunny*) – Walk Back (16) 20 cm faces

Each archer shoots one arrow from each distance in the order of 35,30,25 then 20.

Each archer must declare which column they will be shooting.

Targets must be shot in order vertically either top to bottom or bottom to top.

No target can be skipped or shot out of order.

Field: 35, 30, 25, 20 FT Youth: 35, 30, 25, 20 FT

**Cub: 20 FT** 

#### Target 10 – 65 Yards - Walk Through ½ way to Bow Rack & Walk Back (1) 65 cm face

Each archer shoots all four arrows at the single target face.

Youth: 50 yards Cub: 30 yards

## <u>Target 11 – 50 yards – Walk Through (The Watering Hole) (1) 50 cm face</u>

Each archer shoots all four arrows at the single target face.

Youth: 50 yards Cub: 20 yards

#### Target 12 – 25 yards – Walk Back (4) 35 cm faces

Two archers shoot the bottom targets, two arrows at each target, and two archers shoot their four arrows at the top two target faces.

Youth: 25 yards Cub: 10 yards

## Target 13 – 80 yard – Walkup – Walk Through (The Desert Heat) (1) 65 cm face

Each archer shoots one arrow from each distance in the order listed below:

Field: 80, 70, 60, 50 yards

Youth: 50 yards Cub: 30 yards

## Target 14 – 55 yards – Walk Through (1) 65 cm face

Each archer shoots all four arrows at the single target face.

Youth: 40 yards Cub: 20 yards

Congratulations, you have now completed a NFAA 14 target field round. Most NFAA field rounds consist of 28 targets, which would be two times though the course.
