- We will shoot 60 arrows, at 20 yards, 5 arrow ends, and use a Blue/White Face following NFAA Rules
- Competitors may shoot different divisions, but must remain in the same age bracket, and can shoot each division only once. Competitors may only receive awards in one division and must state which division they are shooting for championship prior to the start of the shoot.
- Competitors must be MAA members to receive awards (can register day of the shoot before first arrow is shot).
- Guests will be allowed to shoot, but will not be eligible for State Awards and only if space is available.
- Awards for the State shoot and Indoor Shooter of the Year will be held around 1:00pm on March 24th. At the West Gardiner Rod and Gun Club.
